- 1) The Virtual Show is open to anyone.
- All entries must be recent photographs or videos, which must not be edited or air-brushed in any way to enhance their appearance.
- 3) All exhibits to be the property of, grown by, or made by the competitor.
- 4) The entry form must be submitted along with the photograph or video.
- 5) For Classes 1-24, only one entry will be permitted in each class. You will not be able to change your entry after submission.
- 6) For Classes 25-32, only two entries will be permitted in each class, apart from Class 29 Limerick (No limit). You will not be able to change your entry after submission.
- 7) The closing date for entries will be midnight Saturday 29th August 2020. No entries will be accepted after this date.
- 8) If your submission does not meet the criteria, it will not be sent to the judge and will not be published on the Sennybridge Facebook page or website.
- 9) Competitors are responsible for checking that their entries have been made available.
- 10) The decision of the judge is final.
- 11) The judges will have to judge under unusual circumstances this year. Their decision will be solely based on what can be seen in the photographs and videos. Please take this into consideration.
- 12) The results of each class will be published on the Sennybridge Facebook page on **Show Day Saturday 5**th **September 2020**, along with photographs and videos entered by competitors. Results will also be published on the Sennybridge Show website.
- 13) The winners placed for each class, stated on Facebook, will receive a certificate and rosette, and a prize for children competitions.
- 14) First and foremost be kind and courteous whilst having fun. All negative comments will be deleted, and you will be removed from the Facebook group. No solicitation, advertising of anything for sale unless posted by group moderator.
- 15) No hate speech or bullying. Make sure everyone feels safe. Bullying of any kind is not allowed, and degrading comments about race, religion, culture, sexual orientation, gender or identity will not be tolerated.
- 16) Self-promotion, spam and irrelevant links are not allowed on the Sennybridge Show Facebook page.
- 17) No breed association is affiliated with this group. All breeds are welcome.
- 18) The Devynock Agricultural Society will store, process and retain the data and personal information provided by competitors for the purposes of operating the Show. The Society will publicise the name of the exhibitors on the Facebook page and elsewhere as part of the operation and promotion of the Show and future shows.
